В.	AET seeks work experience placements for its students with BCEHS Preceptors who are committed to introducing students to work in the field of study. Preceptorship is under the sole guidance, discretion and authority of the BCEHS.		
C.	AET works with work experience placement hosts (preceptors) to evaluate the student's performance during a work experience placement.		
D.	Successful work experience is defined as demonstrating competence in all required NOCP Competencies stipulated by the Ministry of Health EMA Licensing Branch for Paramedic Licensure. This is provided by preceptor documentation.		
Pro	ocedure:		
1.	Work experience placements are arranged directly by school staff through providing student availability with BCEHS. Students provide AET with monthly availability by a prescribed date.		
2.	When a possible work experience training site is identified, AET contacts the proposed site to assess the commitment of the training place host to enhancing student learning. AET explains the school's expectations with respect to evaluation of student performance.
